College Level Examination Program (CLEP)

For Professional Studies Undergraduate Students

The College Level Examination Program offers students an opportunity to obtain college-level credit by examination. Individual test scores are submitted to the University of San Francisco's Office of Admission for evaluation. In requesting CLEP transcripts, the code number for USF is 4850.

The University of San Francisco will grant college-level credits for the computer based testing (CBT) CLEP exams listed below. The minimum scores reflect those recommended by ACE (American Council of Education); minimum test scores are subject to change. Students will not receive credit for CLEP exams that duplicate course credit already given. Since CLEP credits are considered a four-year source, there is no limit to the number of credits students can earn through CLEP. Credits earned through CLEP are not graded.

Prior to taking a CLEP exam, students must contact their Academic Advisor. Their Advisor will help them determine which exam(s) will be of most value to their academic plan. The cost of CLEP exams is \$72 plus a test center fee; these costs are subject to change.
