Osher Reentry Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis to a limited number of **newly admitted undergraduate students** who demonstrate exceptional promise of achieving academic excellence. The Professional Studies Osher Scholarship Committee evaluates the applicants based on the following:

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. Awards are given to students whose collegiate studies have been interrupted by circumstances beyond their control for approximately five years and are resuming their studies to complete their first baccalaureate degree.
2. A 3.00 (B) transfer grade point average or demonstration of academic potential.
3. Financial need.
4. Demonstrate potential for future contributions to field of study; scholarship recipients should look forward to a significant number of years of work force participation after graduation.

The Osher Reentry Scholarship assists with the cost of tuition only; grants and scholarships **cannot** be offered to applicants whose tuition is **completely** paid for by other sources of assistance. Successful applicants receive a tuition grant up to \$4,000.00: \$2,000.00 disbursed the first term and \$2,000.00 in the second term contingent upon maintenance of good academic standing (minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA). The scholarship application deadline for the fall semester is **August 15**; the deadline for the spring semester is **January 15**. Scholarship applicants must be fully admitted prior to **these dates** in order to be eligible to receive an award. New scholarship awards are contingent upon continued funding of this program by the University.

**TO APPLY, PLEASE SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING WITH THIS APPLICATION:**

1. Photocopies of **all** college or university transcripts. Reference to transcripts included in the admission application is **not** acceptable.
2. A typed 300-word essay about your academic potential and potential for future contributions to the field of study.
3. Please indicate whether you receive tuition assistance from any other sources (employer reimbursement, scholarships, grants, etc.) and the amount of assistance received.
4. A resume of your academic and professional achievements.
5. Applicants must also complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA is available online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) . **Please submit all documents in a single packet to your advisor. Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
